

NEW '20/20' INVESTIGATES THE CASE OF A WOMAN FOUND DEAD NEAR A CEMETERY AFTER A HALLOWEEN PARTY — WILL THE ALLEGED KILLER BE CONVICTED AT A RETRIAL?

'Nightline' Co-Anchor JuJu Chang Reports on the Death of Karen Swift on '20/20,' Friday, Nov. 1, and Streaming Next Day on Hulu

When Karen Swift, a wife and mother, seemingly vanished after returning home from a Halloween party, friends and family are shocked when her body is discovered near a cemetery in the small town of Dyersburg, Tennessee, prompting local authorities to start searching for a possible killer. In an allnew "20/20," "Nightline" co-anchor JuJu Chang investigates what happened to Karen on **FRIDAY**, **NOV. 1** (9:01-11:00 p.m., EDT) on ABC and streaming next day on <u>Hulu</u>.

After Karen's fateful night out, authorities found her abandoned car and smashed cell phone on the side of the road. Coincidentally, a few weeks before her disappearance, both Karen's and her neighbor's dogs are found ill from poisoning.

As police investigate, they learn Karen and her husband, David, were having marital issues, and he ultimately became their prime suspect. While at trial, a jury acquitted him of the most serious charges of murder and deadlocked on a lesser charge of voluntary manslaughter, resulting in a mistrial. He is scheduled to be retried on that charge and has pleaded not guilty.
