**‘THE OSCARS’ SET TO AIR LIVE MARCH 2 AT 7 P.M. ET/4 P.M. PT  
ON ABC AND HULU**

Jackson, Margaret Qualley, Alba Rohrwacher, Zoe Saldaña and Rachel Zegler** will present at the 97th Oscars®; executive producer and showrunner Raj Kapoor and executive producer Katy Mullan announced today. Hosted by Conan O’Brien, “The Oscars” will air live on ABC and stream live on Hulu on Sunday, March 2, at 7 p.m. ET/4 p.m. PT, with the official live red-carpet show airing at 6:30 p.m. ET/3:30 p.m. PT.

The 97th Oscars will be held Sunday, March 2, at the Dolby® Theatre at Ovation Hollywood and will be televised live on ABC, streamed live on [Hulu](#) and airs live in more than 200 territories worldwide.
